



- Please submit this RESERVATION form 3 weeks prior to the event date for Council review and confirmation.
- After Unit receives confirmation, make payment at Indian Nations Council Resource Center no later than 3 business days prior to the event or risk cancellation of the activity.
- The Lead Instructor shall bring this form showing approval & payment to present to Camp Ranger with state issued picture ID to gain access to climbing site and/or receive equipment for use.
- A Unit is financially responsible for all Council equipment and gear used; lost or damaged items shall be reimbursed by the Unit at Council direction. A Climbing Instructor may remove any item from use but shall not otherwise further damage, destroy or discard any Council owned material.
- A site endorsement for Level 2 instructor (training to local operating procedures) is also required prior to use.
- Any access safety devices are always provided by Council at no charge.
- A Unit is responsible for having adequate first aid kit and trained personnel present during activities.
- A security deposit of \$300 applies to indoor facilities.
