What is Jamboree?


- Jamboree/Summit (10 days)
- 25,000+ scouts on 10,000+ acres
- Scouts from across North America and the World 20+ High Adventure Activities
 - Rock climbing, zip lines, canopy courses, rifle shooting (3), pistol shooting (3), shotgun shooting (3), archery (4, including sporting arrows), mountain biking, BMX courses, skateboarding, kayaking, canoeing, rowing, paddle boarding, water challenge course, etc.

- Merit badge advancement (30+)
- Patch trading budding entrepreneurs/friendships

How it Works

- 7 days travel/Washington, DC and 10 days Jamboree/Summit July 12 to 29, 2023
- Organized as a Troop
- Scouts will be organized into patrols, SPL, ASPL, Patrol Leaders, etc.
- Adult Leaders (Scoutmaster and ASMs)
- Travel to and from in charter bus
- Will be touring with 2nd Troop from Tulsa Area
- Age/Rank: 12 years old by July 22, 2026

How it works

- Cost, \$3,225
- Initial registration fee of \$300
